Whether it comes as a nightclub brawl, a drive by shooting, or an all out military battle, violence is disturbing. It entered the human chronicle after Eden's gates closed. Then came mankind's discovery of weaponry, which made him an aggressor. There has been abundant analysis citing the twentieth century as one of the most violent. The slaughter of millions of people remains so unimaginable that we hasten to attribute blame to twisted minds or blind patriotism.

So wonderful then was Easter! The triumph of good over evil cannot be overstated. Today's feast of Pentecost has the added wonder in that the Holy Spirit came to those frightened disciples enabling them to believe in Jesus in a whole new way. The same Spirit comes to us now to believe and spread the good word.

Make no mistake, the task is daunting. So damaged has our world become that it wears a kind of "crust" of cynicism over its better self. It is wary of fraud and hollow promises. As the great Lent-Easter cycle of celebration comes to an end, we can rejoice that we have lived through it with our faith both tested and triumphant. We dare not be smug about it, for the threat of violence is always ready to rob us of our inner peace. But such forces will never triumph. We have the Holy Spirit's Word for it.

Registration — 2016/2017

Re-registrations and new registrations for the 2016/2017 Religious Education Program has begun and will continue **through Thursday, September 8th.**

Registration forms must be completed for all children attending our program. All four (4) Religious Education Programs in Bayonne have been unified.

For all new registrants, and if your child is presently in our program and you are enrolling a new child, registration must be done in person at our Religious Education Office, 625 Avenue C (across from City Hall). Hours of registration are: Monday — Thursday, 9 AM to 12 Noon; Tuesday evenings, 6 — 8 PM; and Wednesday, 3 PM — 5 PM.

If you would like your child to begin preparation for First Eucharist, please be aware that it is a two (2) year program beginning in First Grade. Registration must be done in person. If your child is new to our program, a copy of his/her Baptismal Certificate must be provided either upon registration or after, if he/she was not baptized at St. Henry Parish. If your child is unbaptized and you wish your child to receive Baptism and First Communion, registration must be done in person. For additional information, please call Marie Pope at 201-339-0319. Parish Registration

Formal membership with the parish in which you feel comfortable creates a sense of family. It is your spiritual home. We invite you to register with St. Henry Parish. If you are not sure whether or not you are already registered, call Jean at the rectory office—201-436-0857. However, if you are not receiving offering envelopes or various parish mailings, chances are you are not registered. Keep in mind that a person is not automatically a registered member because they were married here, were brought up here or attended St. Henry's school. To register, come to the rectory office, between 9 AM and 4 PM weekdays and simply complete a registration card. If this is not possible, call Jean at the rectory office. Remember that membership with your parish is a requirement if you wish to be a godparent or a sponsor for Confirmation. Parents who wish to have their child baptized or who wish to register their child for religious education must be members of the parish.
