Discerning a vocation can happen in any number of ways. It might come as a surprise to the person called or to the family or friends. Sometimes it is a gradual process, other times it is as quick and bright as lightening. Regardless of how it starts, a vocation to the priesthood or religious life requires a process of discerning, testing and preparing. The best place to begin would be with lots of prayer, receiving the sacraments and attending daily Mass whenever possible. Then talk to your pastor, or a priest you know and trust. Your diocese may have a vocation director who can provide you with guidance and information. The Serra Club is also a great resource for information and contacts to help you discern if indeed God is calling you.

Remember that many young Catholic men have considered the priesthood. Some are ordained and others realize this is not their calling. However, we are all called to be of service to others as we practice our faith. These are extraordinary times in which we live and they require an extraordinary witness to faith and to God's presence in the world. Our work, our ministry as Catholics is to be the body of Christ with and for others. The church needs priests. If God calls you to ordained service in the church, he will provide the grace, direction and support you need. Just listen and respond with all your heart, mind and soul.

St. Henry Religious Education Program is complete for the September, 2017 through May 2018 term. We present our **Year in Review**, beginning today and continuing through the coming weekends:

- Approximately 450 children were registered for Pre-K, Kindergarten, 1st to 5th grades, RCIC 1st & 2nd years, catch-up and Junior High 6th, 7th & 8th grades and 9th grade Confirmation candidates.
- The RCIA Program for adults received 9 candidates for the Sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation, and 1 Catechumen received all 3 Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil.
- The RCIC for children saw 2 young boys receive all 3 Sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil.
- 79 children received First Holy Communion during the first 3 weekends of May, while 6 special needs children received First Holy Communion on April 7th.
- 85 children also received the Sacrament of Reconciliation for the first time in December, 2017.
- A total of 45 9th grade Confirmation candidates received the Sacrament of Confirmation and 8 RCIA adults received the Sacrament of Confirmation or both First Eucharist and Confirmation on April 8th with Bishop Flesey presiding.
- Kindergarten graduation took place on April 29th. 9 children graduated into the 2 year program for preparation of receiving Reconciliation and First Communion.
- 40 5th grade students graduated into the Junior High program, which they will be attending in September, 2018.

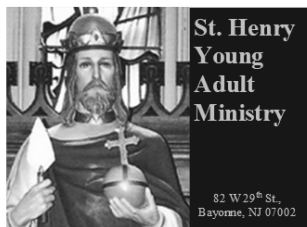
