What the Bible tells us, line after line and book after book, is that God loves us. He listens to us and he accepts our love and sacrifices. With confidence, we believe that God has a purpose and mission for each of us, but he guides us daily as we seek to please him in all that we do. He knows our needs before we voice them

and in love, he responds. Our prayer helps us be open to God, to follow him and love him wherever that may lead.

There are those times in our spiritual life when we are dry, and it does feel like our prayers are stuck on the ceiling. In those moments we learn our dependence on God for life and grace. We feel in our souls how much we need God to make sense of things and to guide us on our way to heaven. We ask, we seek and we knock. In this time and way, God responds, not just with the simple answer to prayers, but with the care of a loving Father. We are given so much more than we ask.

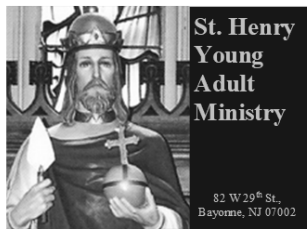
#### SUPPORT GROUPS FOR PARENTS GRIEVING THE DEATH OF A CHILD

### Parish Registration

Formal membership with the parish in which you feel comfortable creates a sense of family. Your parish is your spiritual home. We invite you to register with St. Henry Parish. If you are not sure whether or not you are already registered, call Jean at the rectory office—201-436-0857. However, if you are not receiving offering envelopes or various parish mailings, chances are you are not registered. Keep in mind that a person is not automatically a registered member because they were married here, were brought up here or attended St. Henry's school. To register, come to the rectory office, between 9 AM and 4 PM weekdays and simply complete a registration card. If this is not possible, call Jean at the rectory office.

Remember that membership with your parish is a requirement if you wish to be a godparent or a sponsor for Confirmation. Parents who wish to have their child baptized at St. Henry's must be members of the parish.

### Our Summer Music...

We are using a Seasonal Responsorial Psalm this week and will continue to use it until September. It is Psalm 92. The musical setting was composed by the Canadian composer, Michael Guimont. Your sung response is **"Lord, it is good to give thanks to You, to give thanks to You."**

The purpose of the Seasonal Psalm is to give you the opportunity to memorize and savor it (through weekly repetition). We encourage you to follow the lead of the Cantor on this beautiful refrain.

The other sung Summer Mass parts have been selected from very familiar sources. Since the Parish Choir, music groups, and Children's choir "take vacation time" in the Summer, we urge you to fully participate in the Sunday Liturgy by "singing your heart out".
