Year in Review (continued)

- Ash Wednesday services saw all of the 1st—5th grade children attending with their families and friends. Unfortunately, due to the rain, the children were unable to attend the ritual of the burning of the palm (which is used for the ashes).
- The Christmas Pageant was another wonderful spiritual event which took place prior to our 4:30 PM Family Christmas Eve Mass. All the children were invited to participate and did so.
- The Living Stations of the Cross were presented on Good Friday evening by the youth of our parish. All of the youth were invited to participate under the direction of Patti Marchitto, Robert Mastromonaco, Maria Cantonjos, and other parents who were interested in doing so.
- Vacation Bible Camp was held two different weeks in July and August. Approximately 20 children attended. Maddie Gerard and Lisa Cerbone taught the 1st week and Christine Sorrentino taught the 2nd week. The youth of our parish assisted as camp counselors.
- Our Religious Education Program has approximately 40 catechists and many adults and youth volunteers. All are required by the Catholic Church to attend Protecting God's Children every 3 years and are background checked every 5 years; and all have done so.
- All students 5th grade through 9th grade wrote letters to the students, teachers, etc. at Parkland, Florida High School.
- Catechist certification training is offered to all new catechists and seasoned catechists so that they may become certified at the three levels of certification—Spirituality, Methodology, Doctrinal.

SUPPORT GROUPS FOR PARENTS GRIEVING THE DEATH OF A CHILD

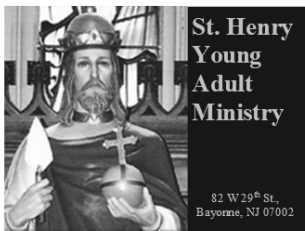

Our Summer Music...

We are using a Seasonal Responsorial Psalm this week and will continue to use it until September. It is Psalm 92. The musical setting was composed by the Canadian composer, Michael Guimont. Your sung response is "**Lord, it is good to give thanks to You, to give thanks to You.**"

The purpose of the Seasonal Psalm is to give you the opportunity to memorize and savor it (through weekly repetition). We encourage you to follow the lead of the Cantor on this beautiful refrain.

The other sung Summer Mass parts have been selected from very familiar sources. Since the Parish Choir, music groups, and Children's choir "take vacation time" in the Summer, we urge you to fully participate in the Sunday Liturgy by "singing your heart out".
