There is not enough space to cover all the reasons that children-as well as adults-have selective hearing. But there is no doubt that packaging and repetition have a lot to do with this. Some statistics indicate startling information: children witness murders, violence, and every form of selfishness thousands of times more often than the positive messages and values that parents, teachers, and churches want to communicate. One magazine reported that even children as young as two shape their choices and wants according to the ads they are exposed to. The ability of the media to shape and influence public opinion, as well as perceptions of value and morality, is enormous and affects all but a small number of people.

To counter some of the negative influence (there is some positive!) of the media, we obviously need to be more selective about what we and our children are exposed to. We need to teach the Gospel well and, outside the classroom, spend more time on the message, so that we all become more aware of it and how it applies to everyday choices and decisions. The repetition comes in the practice of our faith. The packaging comes in us!

If you are not sure whether or not you are already registered, call Jean at the rectory office—201-436-0857. However, if you are not receiving offering envelopes or various parish mailings, chances are you are not registered. Keep in mind that a person is not automatically a registered member because they were married here, were brought up here or attended St. Henry's school. To register, come to the rectory office, between 9 AM and 4 PM weekdays and simply complete a registration card. If this is not possible, call Jean at the rectory office. Remember that membership with your parish is a requirement if you wish to be a godparent or a sponsor for Confirmation. Parents who wish to have their child baptized or who wish to register their child for religious education must be members of the parish.
