We must also bear in mind that faith

in Him means faith in the Church He founded, of which we are a part. The two are inseparable.

The good news in all this is that we have within us the grace and power of the Holy Spirit, who teaches us all we need to know, if only we will listen. We're never asked by God to believe in any fakery like that offered up by the barker standing beside his garish wagon filled with little bottles of lies. Instead we have blessed assurance. Genuine faith is something like electricity. You can't see it, but you can see the light!

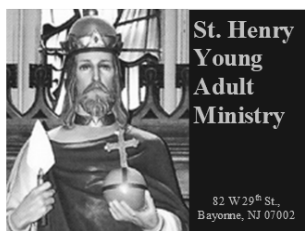
