The Feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord commemorates one of the pinnacles of Jesus' earthly life, when he revealed his divinity to three of his closest disciples by means of a miraculous and supernatural light. Before his triumphant entry into Jerusalem, Christ climbed to a high point on Mount Tabor with his disciples Peter, James and John. While Jesus prayed upon the mountain, his appearance was changed by a brilliant white light which shone from him and from his clothing. During this event Moses and the prophet Elijah also appeared and spoke of how Christ would suffer and die after entering Jerusalem, before his resurrection. Matthew, Mark and Luke all record that the voice of God was heard, confirming Jesus as his son.

The light which shines forth from Christ both at the transfiguration and after his resurrection, is ultimately triumphant over "the power of the darkness of evil". Pope

Benedict XVI stressed that the feast of the Transfiguration is an important opportunity for believers to look to Christ as "the light of the world", and to experience the kind of conversion which the Bible frequently describes as an emergence from darkness to light.

Religious Education...

Registration and Re-Registration continues through August and early September. Fees are as follows:

1 child - \$100; 2 or more children - \$150 Sacramental Fees:

Reconciliation/First Communion - \$75/child Confirmation - \$100/child

Registration & Re-Registration will take place Monday through Thursday, 9 AM to 12 Noon and Tuesday evenings, 6 - 8 PM.

The Religious Education Office is CLOSED ON FRIDAYS.

Important Change in the Registration Process for 2017/2018: If your child/children were registered and attended our Religious Education Program for the 2016/2017 time frame, you do not have to complete a new Registration form for 2017/2018 as long as we have a form on file. You may pay the registration fee by check or money order (payable to St. Henry Church) or you may use our Parish Giving Program

(www.parishgiving.org). Cash must be processed in person.

In order to register your child/children in one of the 4 Religious Education programs, you are required to be a registered parishioner at one of the 4 Catholic Churches in Bayonne.

However, your child/children may attend any of the 4 Religious Education programs, regardless of the parish you belong to (you do not have to change parishes).

This policy change was made to accommodate parents/ guardians and children with flexibility as to the days and times of Religious Education classes being offered through the 4 Religious Education programs.

RCIA - Rite of Christian Initiation - If you are an adult and would like to receive the Sacraments of Baptism, Communion and Confirmation or you would like to become Catholic, we have a program that can accommodate your needs. RCIA classes begin in October. Classes are held on the 1st & 2nd Monday of ea. month beginning Oct. 2nd, 7 to 8 PM in St. Henry School. Catch-Up Classes – If your child/children will be in 3rd grade and above in the Fall and have been Baptized, but have not received First Communion, we have a program that can prepare them to receive First Communion. It is a 2 year program and classes are held on Sunday mornings 8:45to 9:45 AM. RCIC – Rite of Christian Initiation for Children – If you have a child/children who have not been Baptized, we have a 2 year program that can assist you and your child/children to prepare to receive all three Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, First Communion and Confirmation).

As you know, we have two Catholic Charities donation bins set up in the school parking lot. All forms of used clothing, shoes, linens, towels, stuffed animals, books, and small household items are accepted. All items donated are sold and the proceeds are used to support the many programs for the needy as provided by Catholic Charities.

We appreciate your donations, however, if the item doesn't fit into the bin, unfortunately it cannot be accepted. Please DO NOT leave items on the ground outside the bins.

Parish Registration

Formal membership with the parish in which you feel comfortable creates a sense of family. Your parish is your spiritual home. We invite you to register with St. Henry Parish. If you are not sure whether or not you are already registered, call Jean at the rectory office – 201-436-0857. However, if you are not receiving offering envelopes or various parish mailings, chances are you are not registered. Keep in mind that a person is not automatically a registered member because they were married here, were brought up here or attended St. Henry's school. To register, come to the rectory office, between 9 AM and 4 PM weekdays and simply complete a registration card. If this is not possible, call Jean at the rectory office. Remember that membership with your parish is a requirement if you wish to be a godparent or a sponsor for Confirmation. Parents who wish to have their child baptized or who wish to register their child for religious education must be members of the parish.

St. Henry Parish Restoration Fund Capital Campaign

As St. Henry's Restoration Capital Campaign has come to an end after 5 years, we will begin preparation for the installation of the pavers on the plaza in front of our Church which will take place in October. Those who have pledged and completed their payment of \$1,620 or more may have one paver.

At this time, we offer the opportunity for others to purchase a paver: Those who have pledged and paid under \$1,620 to the Restoration Fund can make a payment for the difference; and those who did not donate to the Restoration Fund initially can now buy a paver for \$1,620. Please call or stop in to the Parish Office to make arrangements.

We are very grateful to all those who so generously supported our Restoration Fund Capital Campaign and we are very excited to see it to its end with the installation of these pavers which will honor our parishioners, families and friends while further enhancing the beauty of our Church.

(To clarify: This is St. Henry's Restoration Fund Campaign which began in June, 2012. This is not the "We Are Living Stones" campaign which has been going on in the past few weeks.)

As part of our partnership with St. Vincent de Paul Parish, St. Henry Bayonne parishioners who are in need of food may access the Food Pantry at St. Vincent's. The Pantry will be closed the month of August, and open Thursdays Sept. 7th & 21st, 3—5 PM, and is located in the Rectory basement (entrance 46th St. ground level, near garage).
