Registration Fees:

1 Child \$100

2 or more Children \$150

Sacramental Fees: 1st Reconciliation and 1st Eucharist is an additional \$75 per child for both Sacraments if a child is preparing to receive Sacraments. Confirmation fee is \$100 per child.

St. Henry's RCIA Program begins in October and continues for approximately 7 months. Participants meet the 1st and 2nd Sundays of each month at 1:30 PM in St. Henry School.

- ♦ Catechumens receive the Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, First Eucharist and Confirmation, at the Easter Vigil.
 - ♦ Candidates receive the Sacraments of First Eucharist and Confirmation during the Easter Season, usually in April.

Keep in mind that a person is not automatically a registered member because they were married here, were brought up here or attended St. Henry's school. Remember that membership with your parish is a requirement if you wish to be a godparent or a sponsor for Confirmation. Parents who wish to have their child baptized at St. Henry's must be members of the parish.
