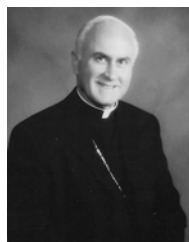
The catechism quotes Vatican II's "Lumen Gentium": "Those who, through no fault of their own, do not know Christ...may achieve eternal salvation" (§ 847). Most importantly, each person has to listen and obey God through the dictates of conscience while seeking truth. That does not excuse the church from evangelization, proclaiming the truth of God's love for us through Jesus. We still believe that all salvation comes from Jesus through the church. The church is necessary for all those who know the church to be the body of Christ and the means that God provides for salvation. In other words, once you know the Way, there are no other route.

Parish Registration

Formal membership with the parish in which you feel comfortable creates a sense of family. Your parish is your spiritual home. We invite you to register with St. Henry Parish. If you are not sure whether or not you are already registered, call Jean at the rectory office—201-436-0857. However, if you are not receiving offering envelopes or various parish mailings, chances are you are not registered. Keep in mind that a person is not automatically a registered member because they were married here, were brought up here or attended St. Henry's school. To register, come to the rectory office, between 9 AM and 4 PM weekdays and simply complete a registration card. If this is not possible, call Jean at the rectory office. Remember that membership with your parish is a requirement if you wish to be a godparent or a sponsor for Confirmation. Parents who wish to have their child baptized or who wish to register their child for religious education must be members of the parish.
