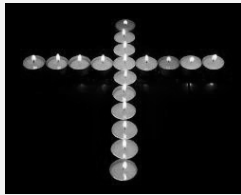

Loss and change are always difficult to deal with, whether that change is good or not. Losing or changing jobs, moving, and watching children leave home can all be times of transition, grief, and loss. But grief is a normal emotion we experience especially when someone close to us dies. People grieve in different ways and in their own time. It is not within our control, nor is there a set time limit. Symptoms of grief are varied and can include depression, inattention, daydreaming, sometimes relief that suffering is over, and an overwhelming sense of loss and

emptiness.

Faith can help us deal with grief. Familiar rituals, assurances of life in heaven, and the love and support of the community can make a big difference. But it does not, and should not, replace our sense of loss. A person who was close to us is gone. That experience is real, it is traumatic, and it is painful. Time will help us adjust to it, but we never forget the loss, nor will anything or anyone replace loved ones who have died. We will always remember and love them. We will always miss them. Love does not die with death.

Parish Registration

Formal membership with the parish in which you feel comfortable creates a sense of family. Your parish is your spiritual home. We invite you to register with St. Henry Parish. If you are not sure whether or not you are already registered, call Jean at the rectory office—201-436-0857. However, if you are not receiving offering envelopes or various parish mailings, chances are you are not registered. Keep in mind that a person is not automatically a registered member because they were married here, were brought up here or attended St. Henry's school. To register, come to the rectory office, between 9 AM and 4 PM weekdays and simply complete a registration card. If this is not possible, call Jean at the rectory office. Remember that membership with your parish is a requirement if you wish to be a godparent or a sponsor for Confirmation. Parents who wish to have their child baptized or who wish to register their child for religious education must be members of the parish.
