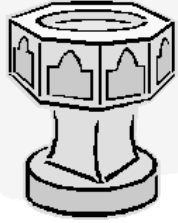

Scripture reminds us of the importance of baptism. For that sacrament, a key part of our initiation to the Church, is meant to launch our personal mission. This pouring of the water in the Name of the Trinity of course has a wonderful personal effect. But it also has the “public effect” of making us spokespersons for Christ in the public square. Christ has chosen to need us, to honor us, with a commission. He relies on our hands and feet, our eyes and ears, our hearts and souls, to be courageous witnesses to Him. “Courageous” because now more than ever, secularism holds sway in the marketplace of ideas. Talk of God is often politically incorrect except as a standard ending to patriotic speeches.

It is high time for us to get past the old notion of a missionary as a priest or religious struggling to introduce Christ to far away pagans. Thanks to our modern tools of communication, the world is a global village, and few people are beyond their reach. A missionary is a person with deep conviction about his or her beliefs who wants to spread the word, without necessarily using words. A missionary for Christ is a witness to His way of life who teaches by living it. Carry your “walking stick” of trust in God, along with wearing your “sandals” of solidarity with Christ as you go about your mission this coming week. When all is said and done, we will then enjoy that eternal “vacation” that God has prepared for those who love Him. The good news is that that vacation never ends!

Food Pantry Availability

As part of our partnership with St. Vincent de Paul Parish, St. Henry Bayonne parishioners who are in need of food may access the Food Pantry at St. Vincent's. The **Pantry will be open Thursdays, July 16th & 30th.** Pantry hours are **3—5 PM (closed in August)** and it is **NOW located in the St. Vincent Church Rectory (entrance on 46th Street).**

IMPORTANT: In order to receive food you must indicate that you are from St. Henry Parish and bring with you current picture I.D. and current proof of residence (utility bill indicating your address in Bayonne).

REMINDER: St. Henry Parish has a small food pantry, located in our Rectory Office, available 9 AM—3 PM weekdays. Closed Fridays during the Summer. Bring picture ID.

Parish Registration

If you are not receiving offering envelopes or various parish mailings, chances are you are not a registered member of St. Henry Parish.

You are not automatically a registered member because you were married here, were brought up here or went to school here. Membership is by formal registration only. To register, come to the rectory office, between 9 AM and 4 PM weekdays and complete a registration card.

Remember, membership with your parish is a requirement if you wish to be a godparent or a sponsor for Confirmation.
