Everyone in the church community has a role to play in the formation and instruction of adults who are seeking baptism. The candidates receive not only theological instruction and spiritual formation but also incorporation into the social and community life of the church. It's more than a good idea; it is the very identity of who we are as a parish and as the universal church. People make up the church and it is into our church and our parish that the baptized come. That help and support is needed long after baptism, because ongoing formation helps the person grow stronger in their practice and understanding of faith. This might be a good place to start when considering what to do for someone for his or her baptism or confirmation.

Of course, gifts are always personal expressions of love and support. Religious articles are always a good choice—a Bible, rosary, crucifix, or prayer book can inspire and encourage the newly baptized. More importantly, the gift of your spiritual support is even better. Praying with her, going to Mass together, teaching her your family's religious traditions, or sharing your own faith builds family bonds and encourages everyone to practice faith together. Sharing our faith

and our love is the best gift we can give each other.

However, if you are not receiving offering envelopes or various parish mailings, chances are you are not registered. Keep in mind that a person is not automatically a registered member because they were married here, or received other sacraments here.

To register, complete a registration form at the Parish Office, Monday – Thursday, 9 AM – 3:30 PM, or call Jean and a registration card will be mailed to you.

Remember that membership with your parish is a requirement if you wish to be a godparent or a sponsor for Confirmation. Parents who wish to have their child baptized at St. Henry's must be members of the parish.

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR POLISH-AMERICAN S

TUDENTS - The Kosciuszko Foundation, an American Center of Polish Culture, is offering the Jeanette K. Nieciecka Scholarship for undergraduate studies in the areas of business, nursing and education. Eligible applicants are citizens and legal permanent residents of the United States who are of Polish descent. A minimum GPA of 3.0 is required to qualify. Qualified Bayonne, NJ residents who are majoring in business, nursing and education receive first preference. Other NJ residents and majors will be considered if no eligible first preference candidates apply. To apply, students must complete the online application and financial information forms and submit the following supporting materials: a statement of purpose/essay, official transcripts, two letters of recommendation, proof of Polish ancestry, a head shot photo, curriculum vitae (CV), checklist and a \$35 non-refundable application fee. Applications and supporting materials will be accepted through January 15, 2021. Scholarships will be awarded for full-time studies during academic year Fall 2021/Spring 2022.
