Too often we act as if the Church’s mission is meant for clergy to carry out. Or we assign it mentally to just about everybody else seated in the congregation of a Sunday morning because we believe they are better qualified, more informed, and especially more holy than us. All of that may be true, but there is no reason to think that we, because of our presumed lower rank, have no part. That, in brief, is not just double talk, but “devil talk”. The evil one means to draw you away from God and lessen your self-esteem. Jesus believes in you. Isn’t that enough, on this mid-winter Sunday, to convince you that being active in His cause is not

just something made for movies.

Here is the perceptive and practical mystic saint, Theresa of Avila, with her take on the matter: “Christ has no body now on earth but yours; no hands but yours; no feet but yours. Yours are the eye through which His compassion looks out on the world. Yours are the feet with which He can go about doing good; yours are the hands with which He is to bless us now.

Keep in mind that a person is not automatically a registered member because they were married here, or received other sacraments here.

Remember that membership with your parish is a requirement if you wish to be a godparent or a sponsor for Confirmation. Parents who wish to have their child baptized at St. Henry's must be members of the parish.
