We are always in relationship with God, even when we are distracted by life, or feeling distant from him. The bible describes us as being carved in the palm of his hand, so we are never far from him. Prayer is our awareness of, and dialogue with, God. It is the way we relate to God, building and deepening our relationship with him. Prayer is the lifeline of our faith, keeping us close to God and in the stream of grace.

There are times when we do forget God, or are upset with him, or feel like he doesn't hear us, or are confused about what we believe and how it all fits together. There are also times when we might feel spiritually dry and just unable to feel God in our life. These times happen. A relationship with God will have the same qualities of any other relationship – ups and downs, times of closeness and times of distance, times of uncertainty. Our prayer might very well reflect these times and we will find ourselves frustrated, unable or even unwilling to pray. Be patient and simply ask for perseverance in prayer. Inspiration will come when we least expect it. God will provide.

Parish Registration

Your parish is your spiritual home. We invite you to register with St. Henry Parish. If you are not sure whether or not you are already registered, call Jean at the rectory office—201-436-0857. However, if you are not receiving offering envelopes or various parish mailings, chances are you are not registered. Keep in mind that a person is not automatically a registered member because they were married here, were brought up here or attended St. Henry's school. To register, come to the rectory office, between 9 AM and 4 PM weekdays and simply complete a registration card. If this is not possible, call Jean at the rectory office. Remember that membership with your parish is a requirement if you wish to be a godparent or a sponsor for Confirmation. Parents who wish to have their child baptized at St. Henry's must be members of the parish.
