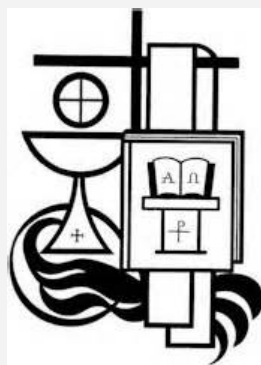

The candidates receive not only theological instruction and spiritual formation but also incorporation into the social and community life of the church. It's more than a good idea, it is the very identity of who we are as a parish and as the universal church. People make up the church and it is into our church and our parish that the baptized come. That help and support is needed long after baptism, because ongoing formation helps the person grow stronger in their practice and understanding of faith. This might be a good place to start when considering what to do for someone for his or her baptism or confirmation. Gifts are personal expressions of love and support; religious articles are always a good choice. But more importantly, the gift of your spiritual support is even better. Praying or going to Mass together and sharing your own faith builds bonds and encourages everyone to practice faith together.
