Everyone struggles with sin and its effects. No one lives a perfect life, and the power of evil always looks for opportunities to tempt us. When we fall, we choose self over all else, even God. We may feel shame, guilt, or remorse. Our conscience will bother us, reminding us that we have failed in our relationship with God and those we should love. We know we are not in a right relationship with God and others, and we need to make it right. Confession, reconciliation and penance are all parts of the process given in the sacrament to help us forgive and be forgiven.

When we recognize the need for change, we begin with confession – identifying the specific things we have done that are sinful. We accept God’s grace and make the intention to sin no more. We see that what we have done is not in keeping with our faith and our desire to serve God, and we recommit ourselves to following God’s will and living our life in right relationship with God, others, and self. This is reconciliation. We seek and ask for the forgiveness of those we have hurt. And then, we do what we can to make it up to them. This is penance – prayers and sacrifices that directly or indirectly help restore a balance of grace.

If your request cannot be filled as you indicate or with the alternate you provide, I will call or email you to arrange an available date.

Once your Masses/Memorials are booked, a confirmation of your 2023 Intentions will be emailed to you. If you do not have email, please include your address with your list so the confirmation can be mailed to you instead.

Beginning February 14th, you may stop by the office for a Mass Card or Mass Intention, Monday through Thursday, 9AM – 3PM; or if you need a Mass Card and cannot come into the office during our regular hours, you can call Jean at the office, 201-436-0857, Ext. 110, to arrange for pickup/payment.
