Evangelization means being a witness to faith. It means living our life according to the Gospel, putting into practice the values and beliefs that Jesus teaches. It is going about our daily lives, mindful of the presence of God in all that we do, in everyone we meet, in each situation and circumstance. Witnessing encourages and invites deeper commitment, stronger faith, and a desire for God. Oftentimes, our actions lead others to question our motives, presenting the opportunity to discuss faith, God, church, and the questions of meaning, purpose, and values of life.

Another way to introduce others to faith is to show others the fruit of the church's work and ministry. Invite them to Mass, a Lenten program, an adult education session, or an information night for RCIA. Let them know about activities, service projects, special events, outreach programs, etc., that they can participate in. Introduce them to the priest and pastoral staff. Use personal contact to make others feel welcome and comfortable. The best way to be a witness to the faith is by doing. Show them that the church is more than just Sunday Mass or a stopover for Christmas. Jesus called the apostles with little more than "Come and see!" You can too.

However, if you are not receiving offering envelopes or various parish mailings, chances are you are not registered. Keep in mind that a person is not automatically a registered member because they were married here, were brought up here or attended St. Henry's school. To register, come to the rectory office, between 9 AM and 4 PM weekdays and simply complete a registration card. If this is not possible, call Jean at the rectory office. Remember that membership with your parish is a requirement if you wish to be a godparent or a sponsor for Confirmation. Parents who wish to have their child baptized at St. Henry's must be members of the parish.
