Each of us has our role in play in God's plan, and we become coworkers with God in the work of redemption. With a little confidence, a willing spirit and God's grace, we can and will respond to his unique call.

Today is the World Day of Prayer for Vocations, in which we turn to the Lord to ask Him to send His Church more priests, deacons and consecrated religious. He knows our needs, and the present shortage, at least in our country, is obvious. So we must place our obvious need in the hands of the Good Shepherd, who in turn hopes for good parents, grandparents, aunts, uncles and friends to encourage such budding vocations among our young people for the future in our Church.
