
Thoughts and Reflections.

Parish Registration

Your parish is your spiritual home. We invite you to register with St. Henry Parish. If you are not sure whether or not you are already registered, call Nancy at the rectory office – 201-436-0857, Ext. 110. However, if you are not receiving offering envelopes or various parish mailings, chances are you are not registered. Keep in mind that a person is not automatically a registered member because they were married here, or received other sacraments here.

To register, complete a registration form at the Parish Office, Monday – Thursday, 9 AM – 4PM, or call Nancy if you would like the form mailed to you

A minimum of 3 months membership with St. Henry Parish is a requirement if you wish to be a godparent or a sponsor for Confirmation.

ST. CECILIA FUND St. Henry Church has a proud history of providing excellent sacred music for our Masses and special liturgies. This is financially supported through our parish budget. As announced at Mass, the **Disciple Maker Index (DMI)** is an important survey that will be used by all parishes in the Archdiocese. This survey tool invites you to reflect on your discipleship journey here at St. Henry.

The **10-15 minute** survey can be accessed at this online link: <u>https://portal.catholicleaders.org/dmi/survey/c4d7t7</u> through **May 25, 2025**. The Survey is <u>anonymous</u>—all responses will be confidential, and the parish will only receive information about the community as a whole.

The Survey is available in 20+ languages and you can select your preferred language when you access the Survey. (Paper surveys will be available for those who do not have the ability to complete the survey online. Please contact the Parish Office.) Each individual parishioner, age 16 and above, is asked to complete the Survey **by May 25**.
