Sacramentals help us connect with the spiritual things we do. They help us focus our attention as well as give us the tools we need to do the spiritual work we want to do. Candles are symbols as well as instruments of prayer; incense directs our thoughts heavenward as well as invoke God's blessing; holy water reminds us of our baptism; rosaries help us pray; prayer cards do the same. These become the "little tools" of faith, material objects that point to a reality far greater.

Lots of things can become sacramental. Like family heirlooms, objects can take on meaning and purpose which connects us with God, the church and each other. Some are universally known while others are personal. When we use something

to turn our minds to the Lord, we should also remember to put it in our spiritual toolbox. It just might be the thing that helps us open the door that leads to faith.

If you are not sure whether or not you are already registered, call Jean at the rectory office—201-436-0857. However, if you are not receiving offering envelopes or various parish mailings, chances are you are not registered. Keep in mind that a person is not automatically a registered member because they were married here, were brought up here or attended St. Henry's school. To register, come to the rectory office, between 9 AM and 4 PM weekdays and simply complete a registration card. If this is not possible, call Jean at the rectory office.

Remember that membership with your parish is a requirement if you wish to be a godparent or a sponsor for Confirmation. Parents who wish to have their child baptized or who wish to register their child for religious education must be members of the parish.
