Absent cake and candles, this day of Pentecost is often referred to as "the birthday of the Church. Pentecost marks the day when the Holy Spirit descended upon the Apostles while they were hiding behind locked doors following Jesus' resurrection. After receiving the power and gifts of the Holy Spirit, these same men went out and preached Jesus' message to the crowds. The uneducated Apostles suddenly became skilled linguists, but it was really the Holy Spirit who spoke through them.

There are three symbols of Pentecost, namely wind, fire and a dove. Wind is taken from the noise the Apostles heard as the Spirit descended upon them. After the wind, flames appeared and rested upon their heads. A dove serves as a symbol of the Holy Spirit.

You and your families could celebrate Pentecost today just as you would for any other birthday. But instead of singing "Happy Birthday", someone could lead a prayer for Pen-

tecost found in many prayer books or online. You could wear something red today to match the priest's vestments. The point is to acknowledge the awareness of the specialness of this day. The great truth of Pentecost is that our ancient Church is ever new, and it is graced with the gifts that each of you bring to keep it ever young.
