In a scene from an old English novel, a boy, going to the church for the first time with his governess watches with interest every part of the service. The preacher climbs into the high pulpit and delivers a piece of terrible news about a brave and kind man who a long time ago was viciously ill treated, nailed to a cross and who feels a dreadful pain even now because there is so much that needs to be done in accordance with his teaching. The boy thinks the preacher is telling the story so the people in the pews will rise up and take up the cause. So when the service ends and the people walk away as if they have not heard such terrible news and there was nothing that demanded their attention, the boy begins to cry. When his governess discovers the reason she tells him to stop crying, that people are going to think he is strange. The story gives us pause to consider how often we fail to do the right thing, how we hold back honest and rightful emotions and keep silent when a prejudice is stated, how we say nothing in the face of injustice, all because we don't wish to be thought of as strange.

Jesus tells us how blessed are certain ways of living that are sure to meet with disapproval from the rest of society. We need to ponder how far we'll go for the sake of our neighbor's approval.

Your parish is your spiritual home. We invite you to register with St. Henry Parish. If you are not sure whether or not you are already registered, call Jean at the rectory office – 201-436-0857. Keep in mind that a person is not automatically a registered member because they were married here, were brought up here or attended St. Henry's school.
