Teaching the Good News


Due to the COVID 19 Pandemic, St. Henry Religious Education classes will be held remotely for the 2020/2021 program year.

In the time of our Lord, long before pen on paper was available to most people, and speech was the only medium of exchange of ideas, a good teacher had to use a special talent to get and keep the audience's attention. Jesus, the master teacher, made it look easy. St. Mark underscored this when he wrote, "with many parables He (Jesus) spoke the word to them as they were able to understand it".

Even we, as modern listeners to Jesus, jaded as we may be by being talked at by teleprompter readers of hired actors parroting for yet another product we don't really need, can relate to a lesson of what a small seed planted can produce.

Each of us is an integral part of God's grand design, and Faith in Him helps us to believe it. We make a big mistake placing our faith elsewhere. But our cooperation with God can bring about something truly wonderful. Realistically, and in clear easy to understand language, there is no better demonstration of faith than a person planting seed in a field.

Keep in mind that a person is not automatically a registered member because they were married here, or received other sacraments here.

Remember that membership with your parish is a requirement if you wish to be a godparent or a sponsor for Confirmation. Parents who wish to have their child baptized at St. Henry's must be members of the parish.
