If you stroll through a bookstore you will inevitably find a long list of what are called “self improvement” books. There are books for self-confidence, self help, self-love, self-growth and self-esteem. As believers in God the Father, Jesus Christ His only Son, and the Holy Spirit we turn to the Bible for the answers to all those areas of concern.

One doesn’t have to go very deeply into the teachings of Christ until we learn the mind-blowing truth about God. One that we would never conclude on our own: that our one God is a community of three Persons. These same three are distinct but equal – the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. There is no sense trying to comprehend this truth in its fullness because that is beyond the ability of our finite minds. After all, God by nature is the Supreme Being. But God wants to be “transparent”. He wants us to know the kind of God with whom we are relating. This Trinity is what God is. It follows that we can benefit so much from an authentic

and deep relationship with Him based on mutual love.

So we celebrate, venerate and advocate for this revealed mystery on this solemn feast day. God’s love for us is so deep and rich that we don’t need to turn to any self-help library. We realize from the truth of the divine Trinity what God really wants to be for us. Someone we can love and know.

Bishop Hyacinth O. Egebebo of the Catholic Diocese of Bomadi, Delta State, Nigeria, will be visiting St. Henry's NEXT WEEKEND, as part of the Archdiocese of Newark's Missionary Cooperation Plan. Bishop Hyacinth shepherds the rural areas of Delta State in the South of Nigeria where although the Catholic faith is thriving, the economic situation of the people is deplorable, with them having no access to potable water, roads, hospitals, schools, electricity, etc. The main source of drinking water is from a polluted river which explains why the death rate is so high among children, pregnant women and the elderly. Keep in mind that a person is not automatically a registered member because they were married here, were brought up here or attended St. Henry's school. Remember that membership with your parish is a requirement if you wish to be a godparent or a sponsor for Confirmation. Parents who wish to have their child baptized at St. Henry's must be members of the parish.
