The following topics from the "Christ is Us" book were covered in class: Bible Library, Deposit of Faith, Covenant, Trinity, Abram Model of Faith, The Last Judgement, Immaculate Conception, Incarnation, Ascension, Mark of the Church, Apostolic Succession, Sacramentals, Paschal Mystery, Sacraments of Christian Initiation, Priesthood, Confirmation, Sacraments of Healing, Conversions, Vocations, Bishop, Priest, Deacon, Marriage Covenant, Soul, Free Will, Natural Law, Conscience, Theological Virtues, Cardinal Virtues, Common Good, Justice, Solidarity, Ten Commandments, Original Sin, Mortal Sin, Sanctifying Grace, Prayer of Petition, Prayer of Intercession, Psalm, Kingdom of God, Lord's Prayer, Liturgical Year, Advent, Christmas, Epiphany, Baptism, Wedding Feast at Cana, Lent, Easter.

We read some paragraphs from the bible and studied it in the context of the catechism for each lesson. We watched 5 minute videos about the Saints of the Church; we prayed together before and after each lesson—Our Father, Glory Be, Hail Mary, St. Michael the Archangel, Apostle's Creed, Nicene Creed, Canticle; we used the Liturgy of the Hours from the Divine Office, and used the game Kahoot to review each lesson. It was a time for praying and opening our minds, hearts and souls to the Word of God and the Catechism of our Catholic Church.

I give great thanks to Ms. Marie Pope for welcoming me to share this year with the St. Henry Religious Education Program.

Remember that membership with your parish is a requirement if you wish to be a godparent or a sponsor for Confirmation. Parents who wish to have their child baptized at St. Henry's must be members of the parish.
