### Year in Review (continued)

- On the 3rd Sunday of each month all 3rd, 4th & 5th grades and 1st & 2nd year catch-up and RCIC children are walked over to Church at 9 AM for Music Liturgy class or Religion class taught in the St. Benedict Chapel. Pre-K, K, 1st and 2nd grades are walked over to Church for dismissal, giving all the children the opportunity to attend the 10 AM Mass with their families.
- 5th–8th grade students wrote letters to a young woman of another parish who has been stricken with ALS
- The students of the component "Christian Service" made gifts, cards and decorated pumpkins for the homebound of our parish.
- Our Children's Liturgy has been offered at the 10 AM Mass for at least 15 years. We are now looking for volunteers who may be interested in helping with this ministry.
- Following the threat to the Bayonne school system, Marie called Chief of Police Sisk to have an evaluation of the safety of our school. A proposal was written by Lt. Ashe and given to Fr. Raul. Overall, we were advised that our school building is safe. One minor adjustment was to keep the first floor main door closed during class times. Additionally, walkie-talkies were purchased through the Youth Group Fund for every teacher, to insure that communication is possible with the catechists and Marie Pope during class times. Summer projects include adding a safety feature to all of our classrooms in the event of an emergency situation.

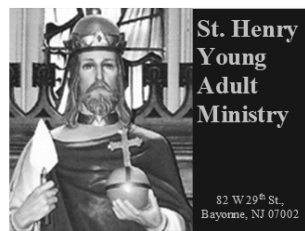
