Why is it important to register in a parish? Isn't it good enough to attend Mass? Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish they automatically belong. At times young adults who have moved away for years think they are still signed up under their parents. But membership requires signing up, formally enrolling yourself in a parish. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social and ministerial activities of your parish. Your registration affects the parish in many ways. Census numbers can determine how many priests are assigned to a church, what benefits and obligations the community has to the diocese, and how Masses, confessions and devotions are planned and scheduled.

Registration shows you belong. It is also necessary for certain benefits, like scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, and getting donation statements for taxes. Most importantly, it lets the parish count on you, to call on you to assist in its mission. Registering in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish.

Your parish is your spiritual home. We invite you to register with St. Henry Parish. If you are not sure whether or not you are already registered, call Jean at the rectory office—201-436-0857, Ext. 110. However, if you are not receiving offering envelopes or various parish mailings, chances are you are not registered. Keep in mind that a person is not automatically a registered member because they were married here, or received other sacraments here.

To register, complete a registration form at the Parish Office, Monday—Thursday, 9 AM—3:30 PM, or call Jean if you would like the form mailed to you

Remember that membership with your parish is a requirement if you wish to be a godparent or a sponsor for Confirmation. Parents who wish to have their child baptized at St. Henry's must be members of the parish.

#### NEW & RE-REGISTRATION

#### 2022-2023 Program

Registration forms were emailed to all families whose children were registered in our program for the 2021/2022 term. If you have changed your email address please call the office at 201-339-0319. If you haven't received this information, please first check your "spam" mail and if it's not there call our office.

**\*\*New registrants must call the Religious Education Office 201-339-0319 or Marie Pope 908-612-6674 so a registration form may be sent to you via email.**

NOTE: We will only be accepting COMPLETED registration forms and payments from both new and re-registrants as follows, in person, in the month of July:

MONDAY—THURSDAY, 3PM—5PM

SATURDAY, 10AM—2PM

SUNDAY, 9AM—12PM

August schedule will be announced shortly.

Sunday class time will be 8:45 AM - 9:45 AM for Kindergarten, 1st/2nd year RCIC (unbaptized), 1st/2nd year catch up, 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th grades. All of these classes will be in person and children will receive traditional faith formation teaching.

Wednesday class time will be 4PM—5PM for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th grades.

Wednesday class time will be 7PM—8PM for Junior High (6th, 7th and 8th grades).

NOTE: There will be a new PILOT PROGRAM called "God's Park" for Sunday and Wednesday 1st, 2nd and 3rd grades. If you decide to register your child for this program a digital/hybrid concept will be in effect. The children will receive 2 weeks of digital faith formation and 2 weeks of in-person faith formation. A calendar will be created and shared with you as to the dates of the in-person teaching.

Confirmation classes will be held VIRTUALLY either 8:30AM -9:30AM; 4PM—5PM or 7PM—8PM, on the 3rd and 4th Sunday of each month, with the Catechist's option of in-person classes for various religious experiences, retreat, stations of the cross, etc. You will be notified as far in advance as possible when these in-person classes will be required. Mass attendance is extremely important for all families and their children regardless of grade.

If your child/children attend Catholic school they are still required to attend Confirmation prep classes at St. Henry's Religious Education.

Young adults who have not attended religious education over the years must contact our office so we can place you in the appropriate class. Confirmation prep begins in the 9th grade. However young adults must attend at least 2 years of religion classes before being placed into a prep class as a Confirmation candidate.

Also note that all children preparing for the Sacrament of First Eucharist must attend two consecutive years of faith formation.

Religious Education classes usually begin on the 3rd Sunday of September and the following Wednesday. However due to re-structuring challenges we are not yet sure when classes for 2022-2023 will begin. Once we have that information we will share it with you.

## 2nd Collection – Weekend of July 30 & 31 MISSIONARY COOPERATION PLAN of the Archdiocese of Newark

The weekend of July 30th & 31st Fr. Binoj Mathew of the Order of the Most Holy Trinity will be visiting our parish for a mission appeal. Fr. Binoj serves as the Novice Master for the Immaculate Heart of Mary Province, USA. At each of the Masses, Father will ask for our prayers and financial assistance as his Order works to expand its ministry of Catholic education in Kamrup (Assam) India. Most of the Christians in this secluded part of the country belong to tribal communities and are often persecuted for their faith by non-Christian tribes. The children do not have access to a proper education due to extreme poverty and persecution. The Trinitarians in India hope to expand their ministry of Catholic education through their newly opened DeMatha Elementary School. This expansion will allow the school to add additional grade levels, dormitories for boarding students, a Monastery for the religious, a playground for the younger children, and an auditorium. Please consider supporting the work of the Trinitarians in India as they continue to spread God's mercy and redemption in this remote part of the world.
