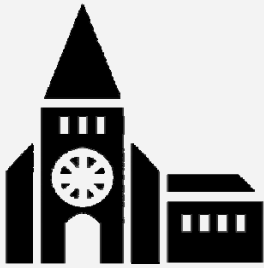

Why is it important to register in a parish? Isn't it good enough to attend Mass? Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish they automatically belong. At times young adults who have moved away for years think they are still signed up under their parents. But membership requires signing up, formally enrolling yourself in a parish. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social and ministerial activities of your parish. Your registration affects the parish in many ways. Census numbers can determine how many priests are assigned to a church, what benefits and obligations the community has to the diocese, and how Masses, confessions and devotions are planned and scheduled.

Registration shows you belong. It is also necessary for certain benefits, like scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, and getting donation statements for taxes. Most importantly, it lets the parish count on you, to call on you to assist in its mission. Registering in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish.

To All Parents/Guardians:

Please be sure to complete a 2019/2020 Religious Education form for all new and re-registrations. If you did not receive a form you may pick it up from our Religious Education Office (see hours above). Registration forms and payments are to be mailed to St. Henry Rectory, 82 West 29th St., Bayonne, NJ 07002, Attn: Marie Pope. Please be sure to write at the top of the form the day of the week you would prefer your child/children to attend classes. If your child/children are new to St. Henry's program, a copy of his/her baptismal certificate must accompany the registration form if he/she was not baptized at St. Henry. If your child was baptized at St. Henry, we only require the month and year of baptism. If your child received First Eucharist at another parish, we also require a copy of that document or the name of the parish, city and state. For more information call Marie Pope at 908-612-6674.

Please note that the registration fee has increased to \$100/child and \$150 for 2 or more children. Sacramental fees remain the same: \$100/child for confirmation and \$75/child for both sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist.

However, if you are not receiving offering envelopes or various parish mailings, chances are you are not registered. Keep in mind that a person is not automatically a registered member because they were married here, were brought up here or attended St. Henry's school. To register, come to the rectory office, between 9 AM and 4 PM weekdays and simply complete a registration card. If this is not possible, call Jean at the rectory office. Remember that membership with your parish is a requirement if you wish to be a godparent or a sponsor for Confirmation. Parents who wish to have their child baptized at St. Henry's must be members of the parish.
