The scriptures remind us that whatever we might be banking on to keep us safe is mere “vanity”.

Christians have a great treasure in Jesus Christ, who personified for us the loving kindness of God. Whenever we feel overwhelmed by our vulnerability we can turn in hope to the life and love that flow from his cross.
