that you are a God of love, not hatred, that you are a God of forgiveness, not revenge
that you are a God of peace, not war.

Remembering these things, we ask you to bless our country and all those defending its ideals
of freedom and liberty and bring them safely home.
May your gifts of peace, love and forgiveness transform our hate, anger and fear
so that peace on earth will be possible once again.
