Scripture is an avenue of growth and insight that cannot be exhausted. It can add depth and dimension to our prayer as we join through God's word with those who have gone before us. The stories, prayers, hymns, and wisdom can be a great source of inspiration and grace. Being familiar with the Gospels and the writings of Paul helps us make them a part of our daily thoughts and reflections.

One way of praying with Scripture is to pick a favorite passage or story and read it often. After a few moments of reflection, jot down whatever ideas, images, or insights come to mind. By repeating this process over and over, you will become familiar with the nuances of the story, finding its patterns in your own life. Another variation of using Scripture in prayer is to collect different versions of the same passage, written or artistic. It can be particularly fruitful to pick a passage that speaks to your life and those with whom you closely identify.
