It is an undeniable fact that the number of Catholics who practice their faith is down from what it was in past times. The Vineyard of the Church in our time has fewer “plants”. What should concern us is the question of how we’re doing as part of the Vineyard. Are we thriving in divine grace and producing the grapes that make for fine wine? Are we living up to our Christian potential as witnesses for the Owner of the Vineyard? Or are we just going through the motions, absorbing the sun that shines and the rain that falls but not putting out the fine crop we did in years gone by?

Attaining the peace of God, which we all really want even if we don’t say so, means pursuing “whatever is true, honorable, just, pure, lovely and gracious” and “keep on doing it”. Doing it day by

day is the key to success. Or one writer put it: “*Yard by yard, life is hard, inch by inch, it’s a cinch*”.

Your parish is your spiritual home. We invite you to register with St. Henry Parish. If you are not sure whether or not you are already registered, call Jean at the rectory office—201-436-0857, Ext. 110. However, if you are not receiving offering envelopes or various parish mailings, chances are you are not registered. Keep in mind that a person is not automatically a registered member because they were married here, or received other sacraments here.

To register, complete a registration form at the Parish Office, Monday – Thursday, 9 AM – 3:30 PM, or call Jean and a registration card will be mailed to you.

Remember that membership with your parish is a requirement if you wish to be a godparent or a sponsor for Confirmation. Parents who wish to have their child baptized at St. Henry's must be members of the parish.

### St. Henry Religious Education NEW & REVISED REGISTRATION DAYS/TIMES

New and Re-registrations have closed for the 2020/2021 Religious Education Program at St. Henry. If you would like to place your child on a waiting list, you may do so by calling me at 201-339-0319.

All parents/guardians who have registered their children by September 30th will receive an email advising of our Meet & Greet sessions scheduled by grade, day, time. Scheduled sessions are Sunday, October 11th, Monday, October 12th, Tuesday, October 13th and Thursday, October 15th. At the Meet & Greet sessions all children will meet their catechist, receive a text book and parents/guardians will be required to read and sign the digital documentation from the Archdiocese of Newark granting permission for your child/children to be taught remotely. You will also receive a welcome letter from Sadlier, the book company we will be using, with your User Name and Password.

We will make this faith journey as easy as possible for you and your children. We understand the enormous pressure placed on your families, and will do everything in our ability to not add to your stress and that of your children. As usual, if you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact me. Please be patient with us as we are treading uncharted waters. We are truly in this together. We miss having the children in person, but hopefully when the Archdiocese of Newark revisits the state of COVID in January, 2021, we will all be back together if deemed safe.
