November 2, the Commemoration of All the Faithful Departed, dovetails with November 1, the feast of All Saints. The saints, our models of Christian living, are one with God in heaven. All the faithful departed are those who have died with hope and trust in a loving God who calls us to greater growth and development, even beyond death. These November feasts vividly remind us of the rich reality known as the communion of saints. This belief stresses the strong affirmation that the church is always one in Christ. Death does not sever any of the bonds that unite us in Christ. That is why it is a fitting practice to pray for the dead and to ask them to pray for us.

We celebrate the Feast of All Saints on **Thursday, November 1st**. We should pause to honor and seek the intercession of our patron saint and all who have died in the Lord. Remember, our destiny is to join with the saints whom we honor living as a holy person and becoming part of the saints in heaven. **Masses for this Holy Day of Obligation will take place at 7:00 PM Wednesday, October 31st and 8:30 AM & 12:05 PM on Thursday, November 1st.**

**All Souls Day**

All Souls Day is **Friday, November 2nd**. It is our Catholic tradition to remember all of our deceased relatives and friends. Masses will be celebrated at 8:30 AM & 12:05 PM for our deceased families, friends, benefactors, parishioners, priests and religious. A Memorial Book will be set up at the Baptismal Font. ### New Hymnals for our Masses

Beginning the last weekend of November, we will be using new, permanent hymnals at our Liturgies. These books will remain in the pews for a number of years. They will replace our paperback "missalettes" which are discarded and re-purchased every year (like a subscription). The new hymnals, called RITUAL SONG, are hardcover, sturdy, and beautifully printed. They include a vast number of songs and hymns which we already use. About half the music is traditional Catholic hymnody and half contemporary or folk culture music. Our sung Mass responses will not be changed. The new hymnals will also include the Sunday readings for each week printed in full. This important change to permanent hymnals will save our parish thousands of dollars. And by not wasting paper nor causing carbon emissions by disposal of the books, we will contribute to a sound environment.

**Note that these new hymnals are to remain in the church and not be taken home.**
