Loss and change are always difficult to deal with, whether that change is good or not. Losing or changing jobs, moving, and watching children leave home can all be times of transition, grief, and loss. But grief is a normal emotion we experience especially when someone close to us dies. People grieve in different ways and in their own time. It is not within our control, nor is there a set time limit. Symptoms of grief are varied and can include depression, inattention, daydreaming, sometimes relief that suffering is over, and an overwhelming sense of loss and emptiness.

Faith can help us deal with grief. Familiar rituals, assurances of life in heaven, and the love and support of the community can make a big difference. But it does not, and should not, replace our sense of loss. A person who was close to us is gone. That experience is real, it is traumatic, and it is painful. Time will help us adjust to it, but we never forget the loss, nor will anything or anyone replace loved ones who have died. We will always remember and love them. We will always miss them. Love does not die with death.

Parish Registration
