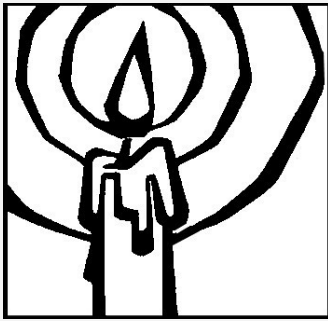

We recognize that we are living in a type of desert. One that offers no real answer to vital questions like “why are we here?” or “where are we going?” This short Church season of Advent so contradicts the attitude of the secular world – it takes these four weeks as a buying spree interrupted only by parties. There’s no need to “make straight” anything, because it doesn’t see that its “ways” are crooked.

So what is the antidote to this short-sightedness? It’s Advent prayer. Most of us never plan to neglect prayer – it just happens. Or to follow the thinking of the pop culture without question – that just happens too. Or even to sideline Jesus from our lives – we just let it happen. Subconsciously we may be afraid of being called a “religious fanatic”. We dread being different. Yes, we come to Sunday Mass, but for a lot of us God gets lost in the other six days of life in the “real world”.

Advent questions “the real world”. How real is it? Is it just the one created by our culture? Of course not, and we know better. We don’t really need cute signs to remind us that “Jesus is the reason for the season” do we?

Remember that membership with your parish is a requirement if you wish to be a godparent or a sponsor for Confirmation. Parents who wish to have their child baptized at St. Henry's must be members of the parish.
